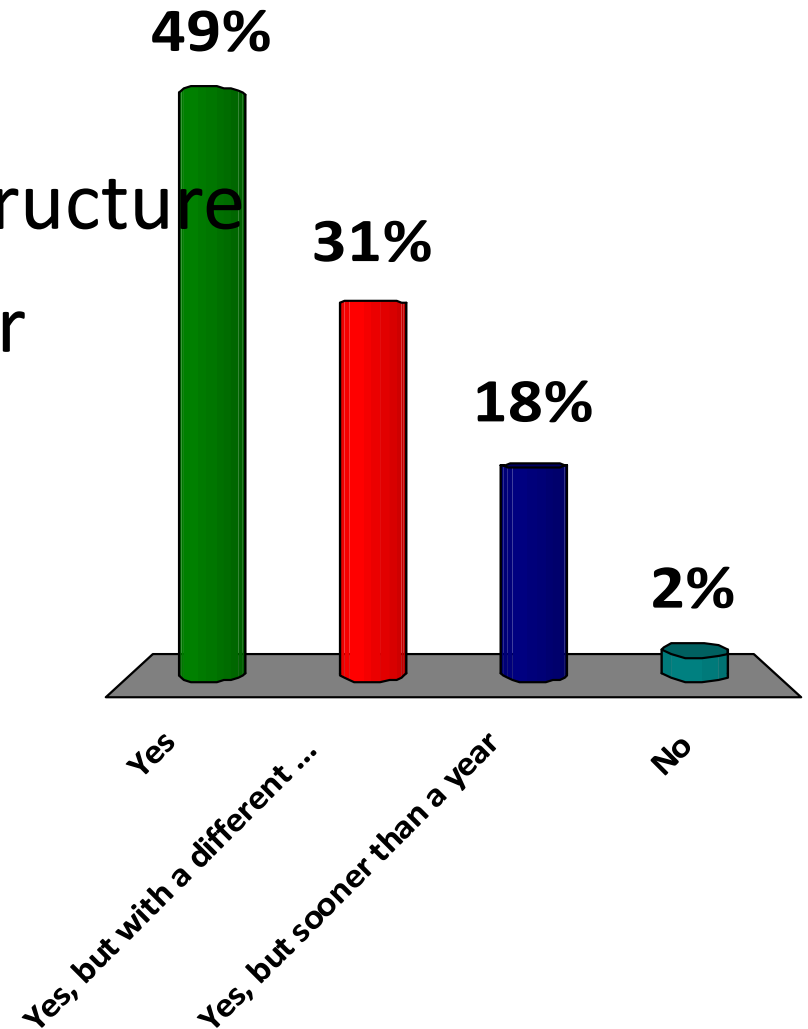
What Is the Highest Priority for National Action to Advance Payment Reform?
