

Randall D. Cebul, M.D.

Randy Cebul is Professor of Medicine and Director of the Case Western Reserve University *Center for Health Care Research and Policy* at MetroHealth Medical Center in Cleveland. In addition to patient care, teaching and research, Dr. Cebul has since 2007 led the region-wide partnership known as *Better Health Greater Cleveland*. The purpose of *Better Health* is to improve the care and outcomes of northeast Ohio's residents with chronic medical conditions through public reporting and a region-wide Quality Improvement Learning Collaborative. In 2009, on behalf of *Better Health*, Dr. Cebul received the region's most prestigious health care award – the Mt Sinai Healthcare Foundation's Maurice Saltzman Award - for "achievement of significant value to the health care interests of our community". Dr. Cebul also serves on the National Quality Forum's Community Health Committee and the National Priorities Partnership Work Group in Population Health.
