## Amit Shah, MD

Dr. Shah is currently Chief Medical Officer at Care Oregon. He previously served as Senior Medical Director of Network Services at CareOregon specifically working on clinical informatics and clinical system redesign. He served as Medical Director of Neighborhood Health Center and previously, he was the Medical Director for the Multnomah County Health Department. He began work in the department as a staff Family Practice physician in September 2000 for the East County and Westside Health Centers. He has held a variety of important positions with the Health Department: served as the Clinic Lead Provider for East County from June 2004 to July 2007; Chair, Clinical Oversight Group Oregon Community Health Information Network (January 2006 – 2009); Electronic Health Record Medical Director Multnomah County Health Department (February 2006 – 2008); Assistant Medical Director Multnomah County Health Department (February 2006 – 2008); Laboratory Medical Director Multnomah County Health Department (January 2007 – 2012). He also served as a board member of Care Oregon and Northwest Regional Primary Care Association. He currently serves as a board member of Quality Corporation and Jefferson Health Information Exchange. He is also on Oregon HIMSS advisory board.

Dr. Shah received his medical training at the Drexel University School of Medicine in Philadelphia. He completed a Family Medicine residency at the Northern New Mexico Family Practice Program and is certified in Biomedical Informatics from Oregon Health Sciences University in Portland, Oregon. He attended the University of Rochester where he received his undergraduate degree in Molecular Genetics.

He is Board Certified in Family Medicine and received his Oregon State Medical License in June, 2000. Dr. Shah has also been a member of the American Academy of Family Physicians since 1994.
