

**Barbara Crowley, MD**

Barbara Crowley, M.D. is the Executive Vice-President of MaineGeneral Health. She practiced as a pediatrician for 27 years before assuming her current role overseeing physician contracting and strategic planning. She came to central Maine in 1986, joining Kennebec Pediatrics, where she practiced until 2006. She was Chief of Staff of Kennebec Valley Medical Center at the time of the merger of Kennebec Valley Medical Center and Mid-Maine Medical Center to become MaineGeneral Health. She has assumed other leadership roles, including President of the Physician Hospital Organization, Kennebec Region Health Alliance. MaineGeneral now employs two thirds of the medical staff, including primary care, fourteen medical specialties, and eleven surgical specialties.

Crowley received her Bachelor's Degree, magna cum laude, from Ithaca College in 1972, her Medical Degree from the University of Massachusetts in 1976, and completed her internship and residency in Pediatrics in the Brown University program at Rhode Island Hospital in 1979. She is Board Certified in Pediatrics, and a Fellow in the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Crowley has been active in many community and professional boards including Maine Quality Counts, the Maine Health Management Coalition's Executive and Foundation Boards, the Underwriting Committee of Medical Mutual Insurance Company, the State Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Maine Medical Association.
