The position supervises a staff of 8 and an annual budget of approximately \$5 million. The Senior Director reports to the PBGH CEO and is a member of the PBGH Senior Leadership Team.

- 10-15 years of relevant management experience in healthcare operations or improvement, with previous executive experience preferred.
- Forward-thinking healthcare leader and strategist who understands the role of payment, policy and purchaser leverage on motivating delivery system change.
- Demonstrated experience and effectiveness in providing strategic direction and management of multiple complex research projects from conception to conclusion, fiscal management and resource allocation and management.
- Deep expertise and experience in quality improvement and delivery system change in the outpatient setting.
- Track record of fundraising and working with financial sponsors
- Outstanding written, verbal and listening communication skills, capable of presenting ideas concisely and persuasively.
