Tim Elwell serves as President and Chief Executive Officer of Qualidigm, responsible for overseeing the strategic direction of the company while spearheading the development, communication and implementation of effective growth strategies to secure the organization's sustainability and business development potential. Before Misys, he worked for the IBM Corporation for 11 years, where he began his IBM career at the renowned T.J.Watson Research Center. At IBM, he held international positions in business development, mergers and acquisitions, and sales management. Prior to IBM, Tim was the Deputy Director for Columbia University's Center for Advanced Technology that promoted technology transfer activities for the Departments of Medical Informatics and Computer Sciences. Previous operations roles included Vice President of Technical Operations and Operations Director for Raytel Medical and Medtronic, Inc., respectively. Tim started his career at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine as a Certified Cardiovascular Technologist.

In addition to serving as the President of the Qualidigm board, Tim is presently on the boards of eHealthConnecticut (Connecticut's Regional Extension Center), the American Health Quality Association (AHQA), the Connecticut Partnership for Patient Safety, and the Connecticut Choosing Wisely Collaborative.
