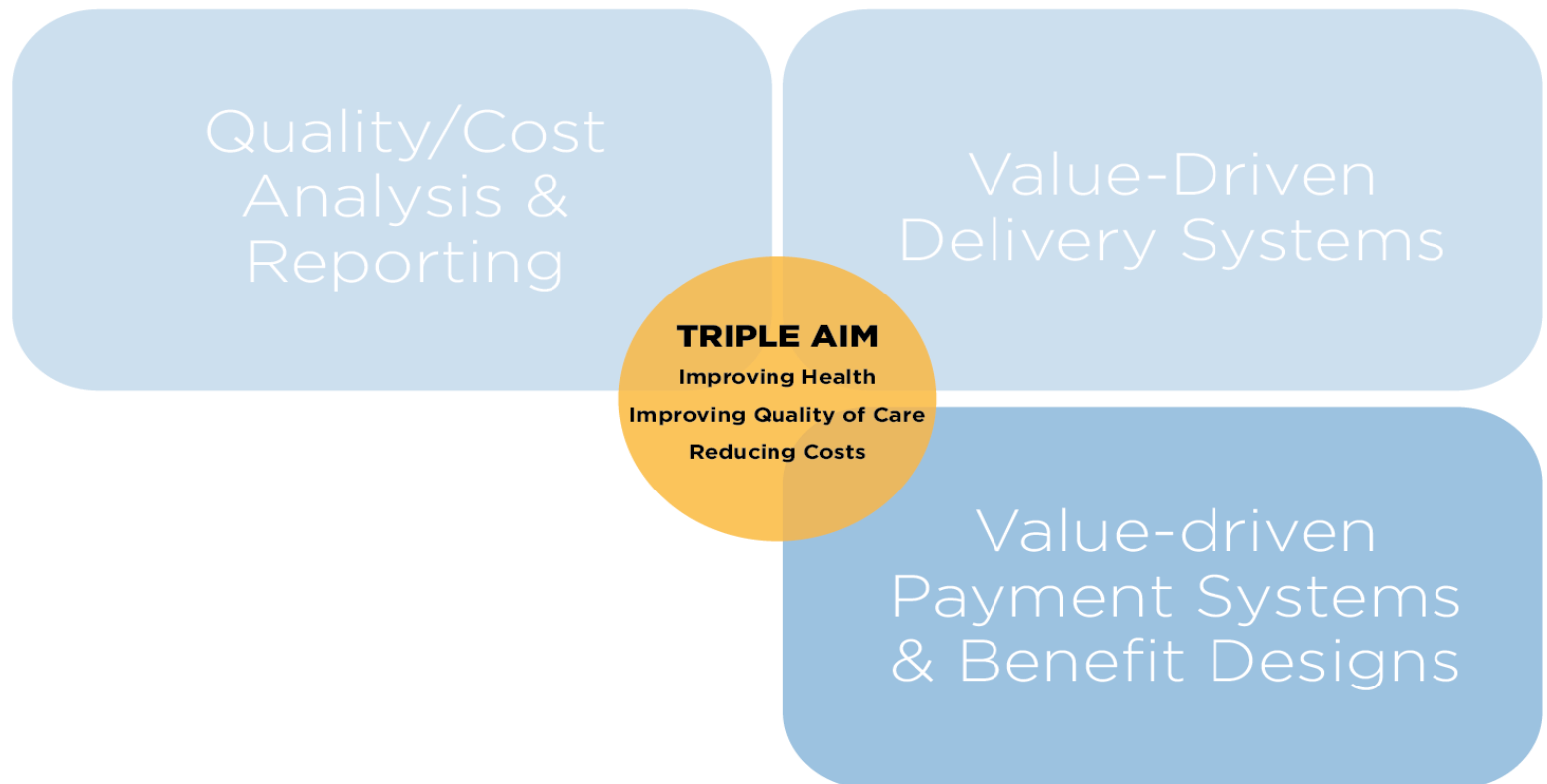

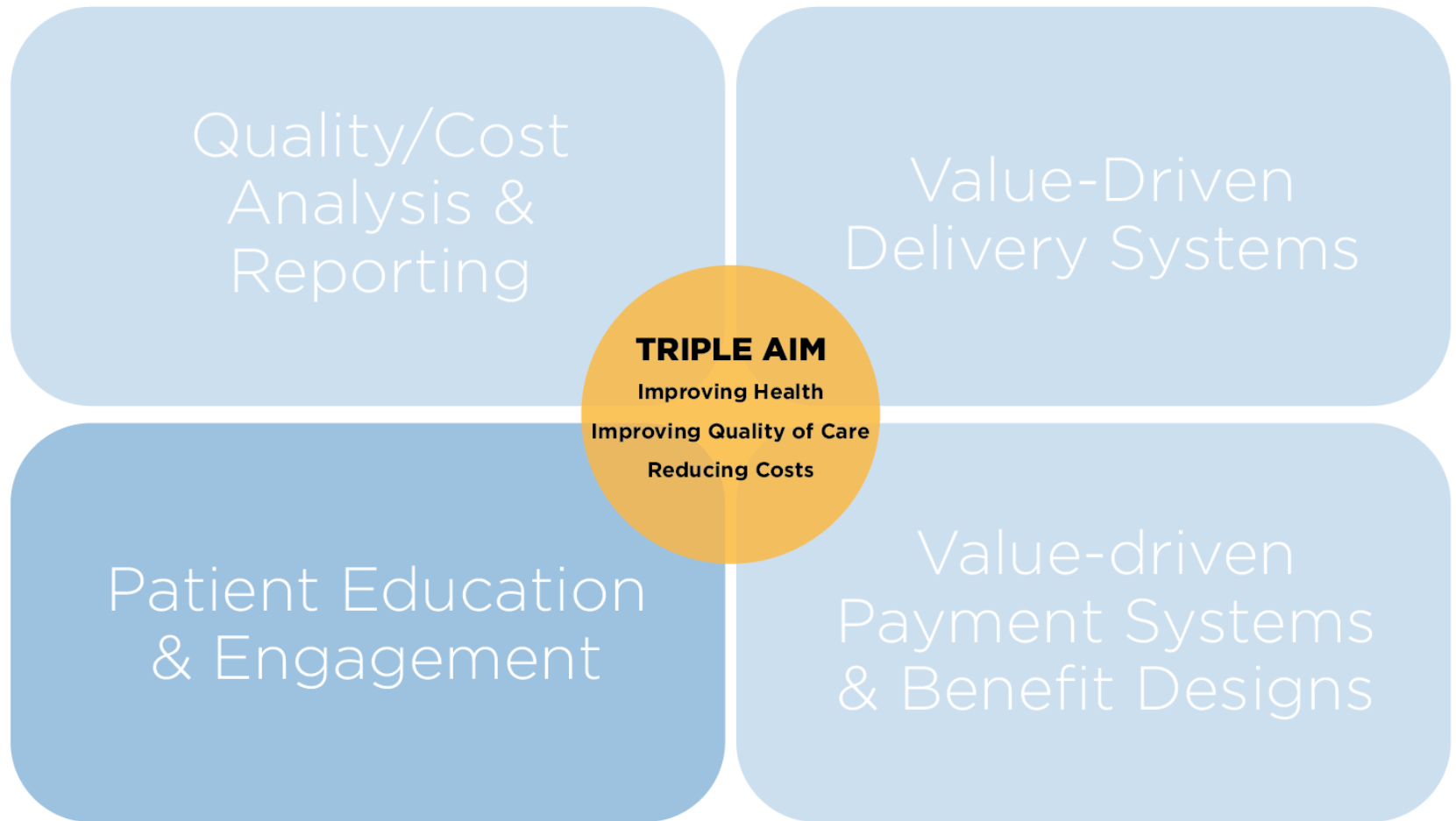

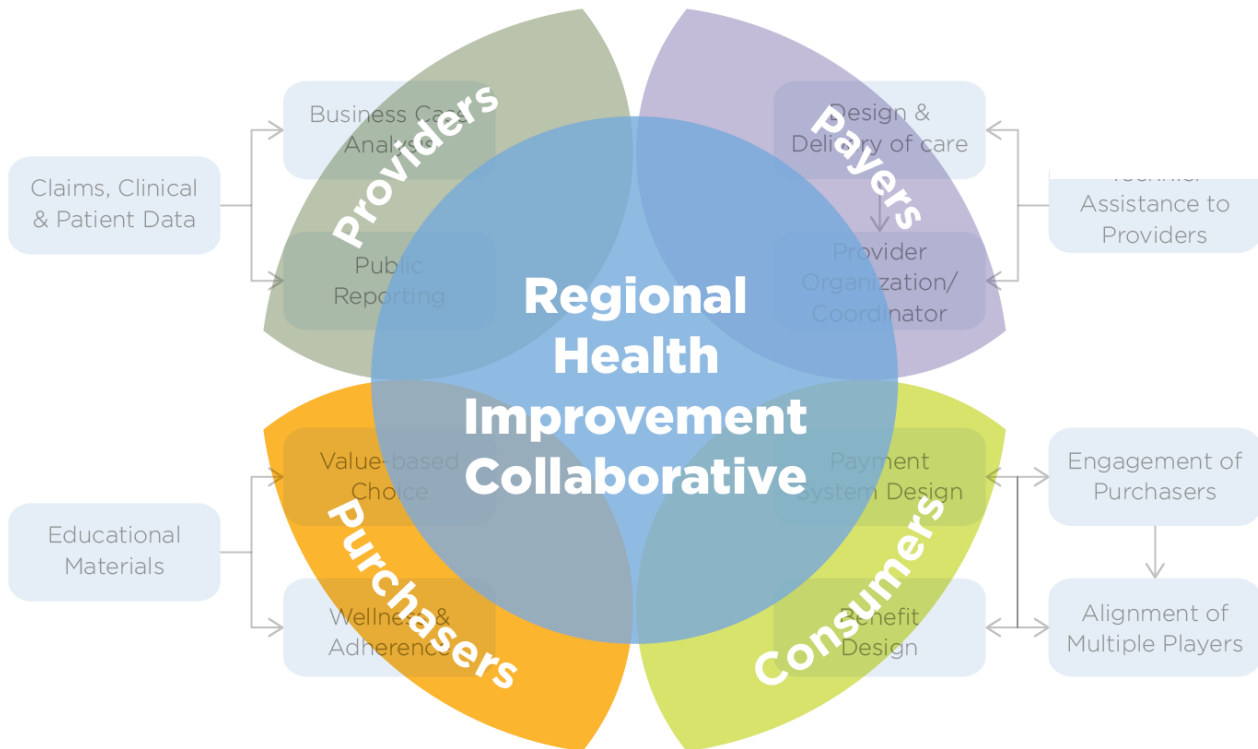

What is a "Regional Health Improvement Collaborative"?

- A ***non-profit*** organization
- Working to ***improve healthcare quality and value***
- ***In a specific geographic region*** of the country (typically a metropolitan area or state)
- Through a ***collaborative effort of all healthcare stakeholders***
 - ***Providers***
 - ***Purchasers***
 - ***Payers***
 - ***Patients***
