



**Barbra Rabson** has been the executive director of the Massachusetts Health Quality Partners (MHQP) since 1998. Under Ms. Rabson's leadership, MHQP has become a trusted source of physician performance information in Massachusetts, and MHQP is nationally recognized for its collaborative approach to collecting and reporting performance information to improve care.

Ms. Rabson is a founding member of the Network for Regional Healthcare Improvement (NRHI), a national network of regional quality collaboratives.
