Michael DeLorenzo is the Director of Health Analytics at the Maine Health Management Coalition. He has responsibility for developing data-based solutions for purchasers and providers of healthcare services, including implementing a new data management and reporting system for the Coalition. From 2006 to 2010 he worked at Health Dialog, where he led domestic US and international predictive modeling activities, developed metrics to measure provider-driven variation in the delivery of healthcare services, developed Health Dialog's provider measurement system, including metrics for effective care, preference sensitive care, and cost and utilization, and oversaw clinical development.

Prior to Health Dialog, Michael worked at the Maine Medical Center's Center for Outcomes Research on various research projects including investigations on the relationship between the intensity of diagnostic testing and therapeutic interventions, trauma outcomes, and other provider systems modeling. Before joining the Center for Outcomes Research he was a Professor at the University of Florida. Michael's graduate degree from Cornell University is in Qualitative Genetics.
