

## NRHI High-Value Care SAN: Summer 2016 — **Where are we now?**

The NRHI High-Value Care SAN is one of ten Support and Alignment Networks in the Transforming Clinical Practices Initiative (TCPi) designed to support clinicians to transition to new, value-based payment requirements established by MACRA (Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015).

The NRHI SAN provides learning programs in various topic areas designed to align with the aims of TCPi. Learning programs are led by clinical and quality expert leads from Oregon Health Care Quality Corporation, Institute for Clinical Systems Improvement (MN), Minnesota Community Measurement, Pittsburgh Regional Health Initiative, Maine Quality Counts, Better Health Partnership (OH), Massachusetts Health Quality Partners and American Board of Medical Specialties.
