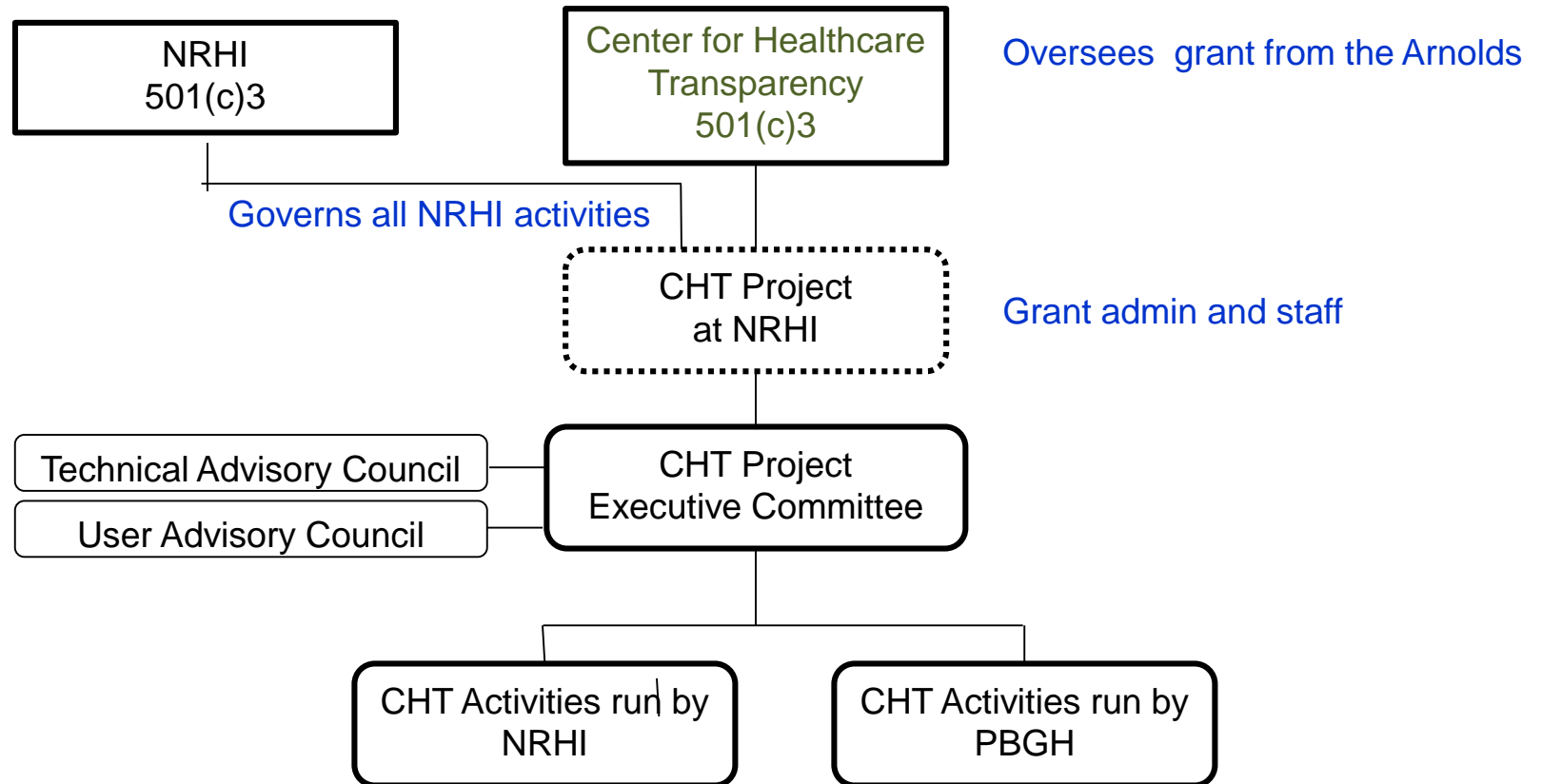

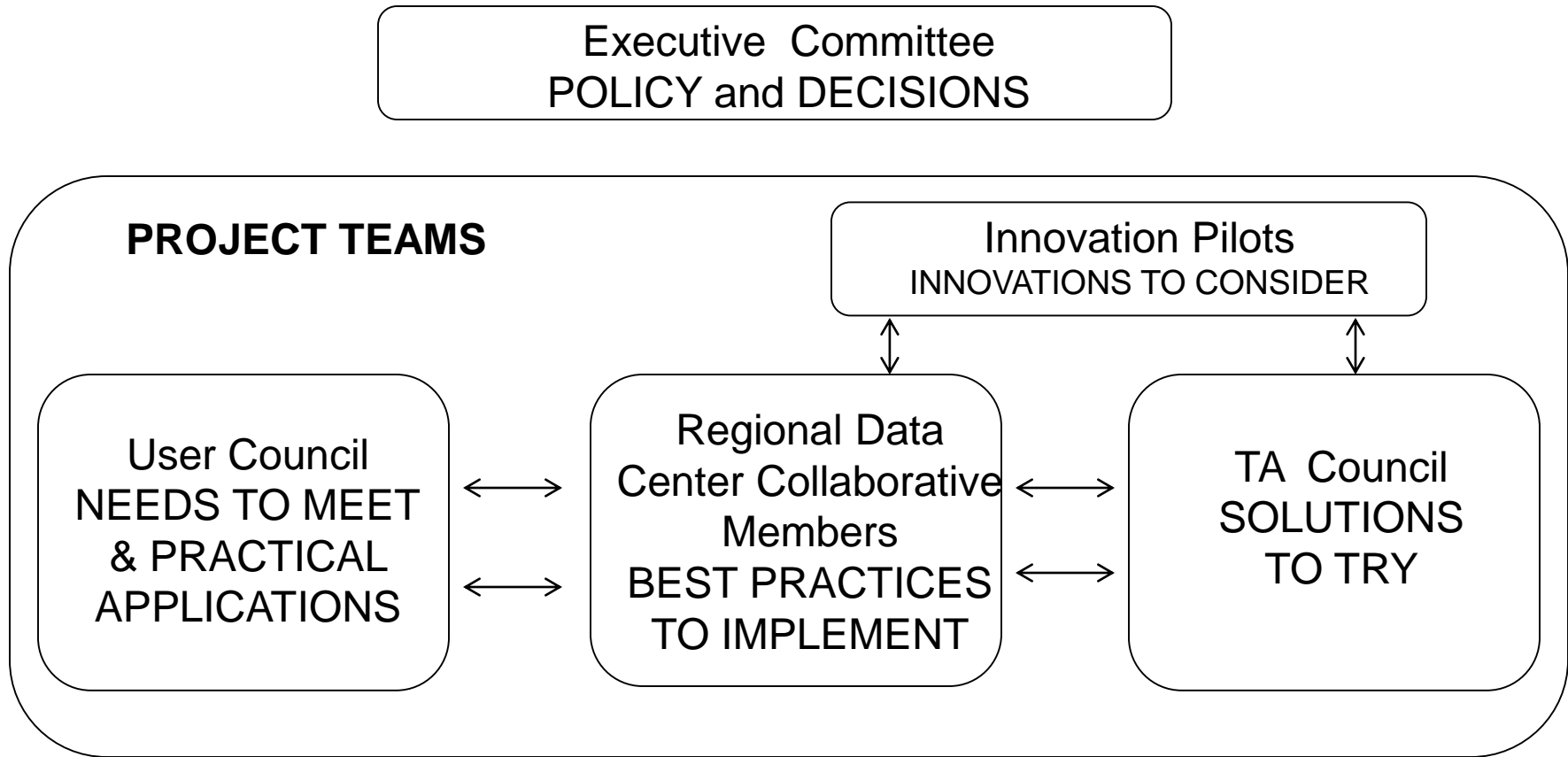
nrhi The Landscape

- Data and transparency are definitively **on the radar screen**
- Lots of related activities to learn from, share with and build on
 - NAHDO-APCD Council
 - ONC Interoperability Vision
 - E Health Initiative, etc.
 - AHRQ studies
- Other mission –driven organizations are planning to produce data or recommend “standards”
- Well funded, aggressive competitors like HCCI are fighting against a potential network of regional data utilities
- But no one else produces transparent, meaningful data that all stakeholders can actually use to transform care

nrhi December 2014 Deliverables

- Collaborative participants, user and advisory groups and associated members names
